* What is CSS?

⇒ CSS is nothing but cascading style sheet which is used for applying styles to a document. It is written in markup language. (It refers to document).

- One can change the look of the website by applying new styles to the old HTML document.

⇒ why CSS is used?

→ Whatever the CSS file there, that can be reused. So time is saved and can modify it any time.

→ It provides a wide range of attributes.

Syntax:-

```
h2 { color: yellow; font-size: 10px }
```

↓

This is a selector.

where, "color" is a property/attribute here. And the yellow, 10px are "values" that are assigned to the properties.
